EARLY-STAGE FINALISTS:

1st Place: Curb the Rain

Curb the Rain acts as an intermediary between porous concrete producers and end-users, municipalities, commercial landowners, or residential landowners, who have struggled to adapt to increasingly intense weather events from climate change. Their products and projects help end users adapt to increased rainfall in urban areas by increasing their storage capacity while decreasing the capital costs typically associated with these projects.

2nd Place & People's Choice Award: Deaf Al

Deaf AI train human-like machines with artificial intelligence to do sign language in order to improve the experience of communicating with people who don't know sign language and make the real world (society) and virtual world (digital world) more inclusive. They assist service providers, organizations, and businesses to be more accessible to Deaf people and to serve these people in sign language on demand.
