# RBC Scholarships for Diversity and Innovation in Technology



### An Overview of the Scholarship!

The RBC Scholarships for Diversity and Innovation in Technology will support Women and members of other equity-deserving groups, including Black and/or Indigenous students, with an interest in a career at the intersection of technology and financial services, based on academic achievement and innovative accomplishment. The RBC Scholarships will be used to support up to six eligible students annually over a two-year period. Each scholarship will be valued at \$15,000/year, renewable for a second year so long as the recipient remains enrolled full-time at U of T and maintains a minimum GPA. Recipients must be 3rd year undergraduate students enrolled full-time at the University of Toronto as of September 1, 2022.

The deadline to apply is: July 27th 2022!
